4. Buyer/Transferee Acceptance - Required

By signing below, I, the Buyer/Transferee of the above-mentioned property, accept the responsibility of retrofitting the above-mentioned property as provided for in the San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) Section §147.04. I understand that I will be required to certify the property complies and make any needed retrofits within 90 calendar days following the change of ownership, and submit a separate Water Conservation Certificate and \$10 processing fee to the Water Department within 30 calendar days after completing the retrofit work.

Instructions for the Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Certificate

An option provided in San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) Section §147.04, relating to water-conserving plumbing standards, allows the Seller/Transferor to transfer the retrofit responsibility to the Buyer/Transferee. Both parties must mutually agree that the responsibility for compliance with SDMC Section §147.04 is assumed by the Buyer/Transferee of the property.

The Seller/Transferor shall complete Sections 1, 2, and 3 of the Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Certificate, and the Buyer/Transferee shall complete Section 4. By signing, the Buyer/Transferee agrees to:

1. Perform any required retrofit to the property with water-conserving plumbing fixtures within ninety (90) calendar days immediately following the change of property ownership or close of escrow; and
2. File a Water Conservation Certificate with the City of San Diego Water Department within thirty (30) calendar days after completing the retrofit or verifying existing compliance. The Water Conservation Certificate is used to certify that plumbing fixtures of a property comply with water-conserving plumbing fixtures required by San Diego Municipal Code Section §147.04. Please check the plumbing standards of the code before performing any retrofit. The property may be in compliance but lacks certification on file. A Water Conservation Certificate may be obtained by calling the Water Conservation Hotline at (619) 239-0132 or visit the official website at: <http://www.sandiego.gov>.

Upon reaching agreement with the Buyer/Transferee, the Seller/Transferor shall submit a completed copy of this form with a check or money order for \$10 payable to *City Treasurer* for the Certificate filing fee. Do not send cash. Seller/Transferor and Buyer/Transferee each retain a copy. Mail completed Certificate and payment to:

The completed Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Certificate must be filed with the City of San Diego Water Department prior to the change of ownership. When using this online PDF form, the Seller/Transferor and the Buyer/Transferee shall each retain a completed copy. The Seller/Transferor and the Buyer/Transferee may also mutually agree to have compliance with Municipal Code Section §147.04 included as a condition of escrow, and have any required retrofit paid for from the proceeds of the property sale. In property transfers involving an escrow agency, the Seller/Transferor shall also submit a copy of the completed Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Certificate to the escrow agent prior to the close of escrow.

The Buyer/Transferee, by signing the Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Certificate, agrees to comply with the Municipal Code within the time frame specified above.
